Community Garden Task Groups for 2018 Season:

1) Composting

The Composting Team is responsible for turning and maintaining the compost pile throughout the growing season.

2) Garden Maintenance

The Garden Maintenance Team is responsible for maintaining hoses, nozzles, garden carts, wheelbarrows, and fence.

3) Weed Whacking and Path Maintenance

The Weed Whacking and Path Maintenance Team is responsible for keeping the pathways and perimeter of Community Garden trimmed. This includes the outer garden perimeter and the main paths, as well as offering assistance to those who need to catch up with aisle maintenance.

4) Hospitality

The Hospitality Team organizes Opening and Closing Day activities, assists with potluck suppers, meetings and other garden related activities.

5) Vacation Watering

The Vacation Watering Team waters the plots of fellow gardeners while they're on vacation.
