

How to Make Paper Planting Pots

Making paper pots is a fun and easy way to use up old newspaper hanging around your house! When it comes time to plant your garden, you can put the pots right into the ground and the newspaper will break down over time, leaving you with healthy and happy plants.



Step 1: What You'll Need

You'll need newspaper, a can or bottle, scissors, soil, and seeds you'd like to plant.



Step 2: Basic Cutting

Use your can as a guide to see where to cut the paper. You can also use an old bottle.



Step 3: Wrap Paper Around the Can



Step 4: Fold the Bottom of the Pot

Fold your paper in across the bottom of the can to form the bottom of the pot.



Step 5: Flatten the Bottom

Remove your newspaper from the can and flatten out the bottom with your fingers so it will be able to stand.



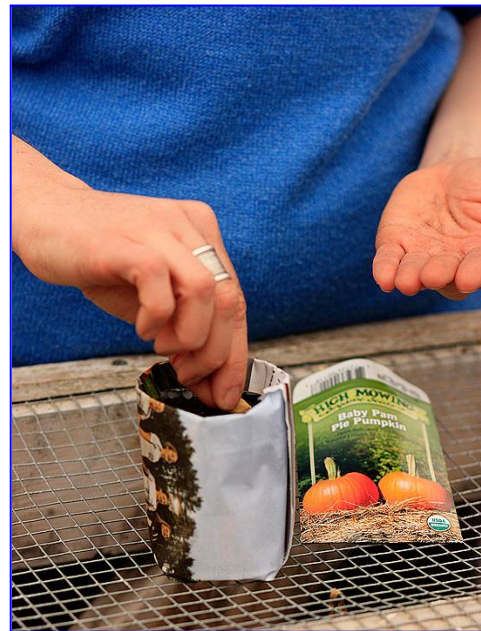
Step 7: Fill With Soil

Fold in the top edges of your pot to make it more secure.
