AGREEMENT TO FOLLOW GARDEN REQUIREMENTS

- Participate in opening day (May 1, 2022 – 9:30 AM) and closing day (November 6, 2022).
- Keep my plot weeded and tended.
- Keep my half of the aisle around my plot trimmed to ground level and free of plants/objects.
- Use organic gardening practices.
- Start planting my plot by May 19, 2022.
- Follow land use and parking rules and other program requirements.
- Clear my plot at the end of the gardening season by November 6, 2022.
- Participate in a Task Group to make the garden safe, productive, and attractive.
- Abide by the regulations in the Welcome Packet.

TASK GROUPS FOR THE 2022 SEASON

Each gardener must sign up to be a member of a Task Group for the season. Each group will make its own schedule to perform its duties based on gardener availability. If you do not choose a group, you will be assigned one. Anyone who does not participate in a Task Group will lose their plot.

Please select two of the following task groups. Write the number 1 next to your first choice and the number 2 next to your second choice:

_____ **Vegetation Management:** The Vegetation Management Team trims the vegetation along the path on the wooded side of the garden so that the Farm’s landscaping company can run its mowers and keep the path trimmed and free of poison ivy and other plants that can invade the garden. The Vegetation Management Team also trims growth along the compost area and removes plants that are growing on the garden fence.

_____ **Equipment Maintenance:** The Equipment Maintenance Team maintains hoses, nozzles, garden carts, wheelbarrows, and fencing around the garden.

_____ **Mentoring:** The Mentoring Team answers gardeners’ questions about best practices for organic gardening, including weed and pest control, growing vegetables using companion planting and other strategies, using winter cover crops, maintaining healthy soil, and saving seeds.

_____ **Hospitality:** The Hospitality Team organizes opening and closing day activities and assists with potluck suppers, meetings, and other garden-related activities.

_____ **Vacation Watering:** The Vacation Watering Team waters the plots of fellow gardeners (at their request) while they’re on vacation.
